2. Lack of collaboration in the organic sector $\rightarrow \downarrow$ competitiveness





✓ Income of the farmers \uparrow 20-30% → Maintain rural employment




✓ A future producer organisation is being developed




 ✓ Improvement of the advising services provided by the Professional Agricultural Organizations




 Research centers can focus in a better way their projects: the network of farmers helps them to know better the farmers' needs
