Established in 1988 as an amalgamation of two separate bodies embracing Research, and Education & Advisory/Extension


State Advisory/Extension and Education service a legacy of 100+ years

Profitability/Competitiveness Productivity Relative prices = f (Useable knowledge = innovation)








Teagasc Agricultural Knowledge Innovation System (AKIS)
